Then a pregnant woman a friend of his daughter Phoebe's disappears, and when Quirke enlists his friend Inspector Hackett to help him find her, the two untangle a string of events leading into an underworld where a powerful figure hides behind politics and religion. Written by Man Booker Prize winner John Banville under the pen name Benjamin Black, the Quirke mystery series follows the criminal pathologist's cases in 1950s Dublin, and inspired the BBC television series of the same name. 262.
