

Extending from 5 degrees north of the equator to the 33rd parallel south, a variety of climatic zones is encountered. Although the geographical equator crosses the northern portion, all of the country lies below the thermal equator (which runs through Central America) and thus occupies a favorable middle position between the line of extreme heat and the cold southern latitudes. Due to the greater part of the country being an elevated plateau, the extensive coast line and the greatest hydrographic system in the world, the solar heat of the tropical portions is greatly modified, sunstrokes are almost unknown, and the climate in the populated districts is surprisingly agreeable. Chief Physical Characteristics: The country may be divided into two large physical regions, that of the east and center being generally high and that in the north and west containing extensive plains and valleys. The central plateau covers about half of the Republic and is from 500 to 1,000 meters (1,600 to 3,200 feet) above sea level. North of this the great Amazon Valley stretches from the...
