Excerpt: . . . by this act, who shall, upon being so appointed, have like powers and duties under this act as county attorney. And in case of such appointment of any person in place of the county attorney to prosecute for violation of this act in any county, the county commissioners shall allow and pay to such prosecuting attorney a reasonable compensation for all services performed by him as such prosecutor. Sec. 7. This act shall not be held to apply to hail, wind, or live stock insurance companies, now or hereafter organized under the laws of this state, nor to mutual aid associations, benefit societies or co-operative life insurance societies wherever organized.
