The Fungus. - Apple blotch is a fungus growing on the fruit, foliage, and twigs of the apple. It is seldom a serious trouble on foliage, where it is evidenced by small grayish-white spots. On the fruit, twigs, and fruit spurs it becomes extremely serious on susceptible varieties. On the fruit, the disease first makes its appearance as a small brown spot which rapidly enlarges, showing a ragged border of radiating splashes. Severe infections are followed by a cracking open of the apple toward the...
